

# Come to the Théâtre National

It couldn't be simpler to get to us. The Théâtre National is ideally located between De Brouckère and Rogier metro/tram stations.

We're also very close to the Gare du Nord which is just 10 minutes on foot.

In this booklet, you'll find all the information you need for your stay with us.

## From Brussels Airport Zaventem (12 km)

**Taxi:** Duration 20 - 40' – Fee 40€ - 50€ **Train:** Duration 17' – Fee 9€. The station is located under the terminal (-1 level). (4 trains/hour going to the Gare du Nord)

# From Brussels Airport Charleroi (70 km)

Taxi: Duration 50' - Fee 100€
Bus/shuttle: Duration 60' - Fee 14€
(1 bus/half hour going to the Gare de Bruxelles-Midi)

# From Gare du Nord

Taxi: Duration 10' - Fee 5€ On foot: Duration 10'

# From Gare du Midi (Bruxelles Zuid)

Taxi: Duration 15' – Fee 14€ Metro: Duration 15' – Fee 2,40€ (to De Brouckère station on tram lines 3 & 4, or to Rogier Station on metro lines 2 & 6)



# Once you're here

When you arrive, come to the entrance of the theatre let a member of staff know who you are. We'll come to welcome you and explain how we work.

#### Here are the main points :

Keyless access to dressing rooms, the doors open with a code.

You will receive a code before your arrival. Please leave your valuables in the dressing room.

Snacks are available in the dressing rooms on performance days.

We're pleased to offer you a reusable metal water bottle. Be sure to rinse it carefully before first use. Water fountains are available on each floor to fill up.

A common area is located on the fifth floor with a refectory, a terrace where smoking is permitted, as well as a coffee machine which concocts delicious beverages for free.
